



ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Harrisburg Section of the American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) is pleased to announce the continuation of its scholarship program for the 2012 calendar year. Interested students should complete the attached application and return it to:

Note: Applications must be postmarked by January 18, 2012 to be considered for the 2012 Scholarship Award.

1. **AMOUNT:** Seven (7) scholarships of \$1,500 each will be awarded. The amounts will be paid as lump sum awards.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:**
 - a. The applicant must be a citizen of the United States or have permanent resident status.
 - b. The applicant must be enrolled in, or planning to enroll in, a four-year college program leading to a bachelor's degree in engineering, preferably civil engineering.
 - c. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only one time.
 - d. The applicant must submit copies of SAT scores and High School or College transcripts.
 - e. If selected, the recipient is strongly encouraged to attend the ASHE dinner meeting on March 5, 2012 to receive their award.
3. **EVALUATION:** Each applicant will be evaluated on a point-count system as described below:
 - a. Performance Factors, 25 points maximum as follows:
 - High School Seniors will be rated on their SAT scores. The verbal score will count for a maximum of 10 points (5 points writing and 5 points critical reading) and the math score for a maximum of 15 points.
 - College students will be rated on their cumulative grade point average at the time they apply for the scholarship.
 - b. Evaluation of Applicant, 75 points maximum as follows:
 - Evaluation of the applicant's activities and honors, work experience, leadership positions and distinguishing qualifications (25 points maximum).
 - Evaluation of career goals, based on content, clarity of ambitions, grammar, spelling and neatness (25 points maximum).
 - Enrollment or plans for enrollment in a Civil Engineering major (15 point bonus).
 - Dependent of a member of ASHE, Harrisburg Section (10 point bonus).
 - c. Science/Math Teacher Evaluation

The student's Science or Math teacher should provide an objective evaluation regarding academics, character and perceived financial need on the enclosed "Science/Math Teacher Recommendation Form". This form can be mailed separate from the Student's Application.
4. **INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FORM**
 - a. Be as complete as possible while filling out this application. Each portion of the application has a specific point value. Judges will score each section separately. Incomplete applications will **not** be considered.
 - b. Forms must be typed or neatly printed. Points may be lost for poor grammar, incorrect spelling, illegibility, or lack of neatness. Proofread carefully.
